This activity can be used with children aged 7-8 years. It is designed to help them learn about sentence parts and identify a subject and an object. It also develops comprehension skills.

Learning About Sentence Parts

A sentence has a subject. It tells who or what does something. A sentence also has an object. It tells what someone or something does.

Put a circle around the subject in each sentence. Then draw a line under the verb and object in each sentence. The first one is done for you.
