This activity can be used with children aged 7-8 years.
It teaches the spelling rules when adding 'ing' to words. Some words need a double consonant when adding 'ing', some need the vowel 'e' dropped and some stay the same.

Adding 'ing' to words

Sort the words into the right boxes using one of the three rules:

1. Words that don't change when you add 'ing'.
2. Words that end with a consonant that must be doubled when adding 'ing'.
3. Words that need the vowel 'e' dropped when adding 'ing'.
