## Make a Paper Chatterbox

### What you need:

One square sheet  
of paper

Pens or  
pencils



### What to do:



1. Fold the paper in half to make a triangle.



2. Fold the triangle in half again.



3. Now open the paper up into a square.



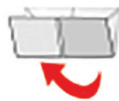
4. Fold each corner into the middle.



5. Turn your paper over and fold each corner into the middle again.



6. Fold your paper in half to make a rectangle.



7. Slide your thumb and pointer fingers into the slots and push up.



Draw some pictures on the outside, add some numbers on the inside and write some funny messages under each of the flaps. Now you're ready to play!
