A statement begins with a capital letter and ends with a full stop.

The giraffe is happy.

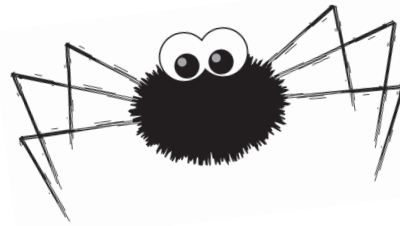
Is the giraffe happy?
